Positions Statements Related to the Practice of Aesthetics Issued by the Cosmetology Examining Board

The Cosmetology Examining Board has approved this forfeiture grid on assessing forfeitures for administrative rule violations. The Board assesses a forfeiture based on whether the offense is a first-, second-, or third-time offense. In some cases a forfeiture is assessed according to the length of time of the violation (timeline: 0 - to 5 months, 6 months to 1 year, 1 year or more). The Board has been able to expedite the closing of complaints by using this grid.

Yes, these procedures are within the scope of practice for an aesthetician as defined in Wis. Stat. § 454.01(1) & (2).

HOW MANY CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS ARE REQUIRED BY THE NEW CE RULES?

Starting with the 2013 biennial registration period (April 1, 2011- March 31, 2013, 4 credits are required. Note, new licensees (people first licensed in the applicable biennium) are exempt from reporting in the biennium in which they are first licensed.
