## RESEARCHER REQUEST PARAMETERS

The data submitted to the PDMP database include:

1. The dispenser's full name.
2. The dispenser's DEA number.
3. The date dispensed.
4. The prescription number, if applicable.
5. The NDC number of the monitored prescription drug.
6. The quantity dispensed.
7. The estimated number of days of drug therapy.
8. The practitioner's full name.
9. The practitioner's DEA number.
10. The date prescribed.
11. An indication as to whether the dispensing partially filled the prescription order.
12. The patient's full name.
13. The patient's address, or if the patient is an animal, the owner of the patient's address, including street address, city, state and ZIP code.
14. The patient's date of birth, or if the patient is an animal, the owner of the patient's date of birth.
15. The patient's gender.

The specific de-identified data that a researcher may obtain include:

1. Patient county or zip code
2. Patient birth year or age range
3. Patient gender
4. Prescriber county or zip code
5. Date Rx written
6. Date Rx filled
7. Drug name and strength
8. Quantity
9. Estimated days supply
10. Partial fill indicator
11. Dispenser county or zip code



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The WI PDMP will not provide:

- DEA numbers
- Patient addresses
- Patient names
- Patient DOB
- Prescriber names
- Prescriber addresses
- Dispenser names
- Dispenser addresses

The WI PDMP may provide data:

- By schedule (all schedule IIs, schedules II and III together, etc)
- By drug class (pain reliever, sedative, stimulant, tranquilizer)

Depending on the complexity of the request, the timeframe for fulfilling the request will vary. Incomplete or ambiguous requests will not be fulfilled. The WI PDMP will track and retain a copy of all de-identified data obtained for research purposes. The WI PDMP staff will not perform any sorting or analysis of the requested data, including reports on specific products or individual drugs.
