

Commerce Internet Tank Search Application

The display at the right shows the web page that allows an individual to conduct a search of the Commerce Storage Tank Database. The storage tank database includes both underground and aboveground tanks that are required by the SPS 310 Code to be registered with Commerce. The database reflects tanks that have been registered. If your search does not produce a tank, this does not guarantee that a tank does not exist on the property. Some tanks, such as heating fuel tanks in the basement of homes are not required to be registered. Some tanks, while required to be registered, have not been registered and therefore will not appear on the database.

If you are performing a search for the first time, please refer to the Search Instructions.

The search time as well as the length of the search report corresponds with the amount of data being searched. Searches should be narrowed as much as possible. If you are looking for tank information relating to a specific facility the search should be narrowed to: County, Municipality, Tank Type and Address. Current day addresses may be different then past addresses and many tanks had been registered by post office box number (P.O. Box.) or Rural Routes that no longer exist. If the search by address does not produce results perform a general municipality search to obtain a list of tanks to screen such as that displayed directly below. Another option is by County (do not enter Municipality).

The notation in the upper left corner of the Search Results confirms the search parameters.

Below the notation is the number of tanks that the search obtained. The page displays 36 tanks on the screen, so you will have to click the button at the bottom of the page to take you to the next group of tanks


The screen and font display are dependent upon your browser setting. The smaller the text setting, the more information displayed on the screen without additional scrolling. This may also impact the printer cutting off the page and displaying the width of text on two pages. This can be remedied by changing the print setting to “landscape” and/or changing the text setting on your browser. Changing the text setting of the browser is described in the next paragraph.

The display to the right has a browser text setting at “medium.” To configure text/font size so that all information is shown on the screen and the contents of the Tank Detail list is printed on one page select “View” – “Text Size” – “Smallest”



The screen displayed to the right is now more compact and has the text displayed in rows. This should also print with all the screen image width printed on one side of a sheet of paper

The Internet tank search application includes the Permit-To-Operate (PTO) expiration date for those USTs requiring a PTO. If the date reflected on the tank detail screen is previous to the date that you are conducting the inquiry, the tank does not have a valid permit permit-to-operate.



The Internet tank search application also includes a reference to the annual inspection status as recorded in the Internet Inspection Reporting Application (IIRA). Since the IIRA was initiated for the state 2004 fiscal year, the reference will be from FY 2004 inspections (July 1, 2003) and forward.

The reference includes the IIRA transaction number for the respective year. The "Type" of inspection references "AN" and "SA" for Commerce inspector and "LP" for LPO (contract) inspector. The reference also includes the inspection status. If the inspection is closed (completed with no pending enforcement issues) the status is "CLOS" and the date that the information was entered into the IIRA.

Pending enforcement actions are reflected in a "Status" such as order "ORDR", red-tag – "REDT", and referred to legal – "RLEG."



Commerce assigned tank inspectors may go directly to the IIRA Inspection Log-In screen from the Internet Search Application.



“Administrative” status designations

The department is occasionally presented with situations where the property owner has not voluntarily updated the status of the tank on the property. This situation typically occurs for tanks on the property that are no longer in use; or where there is a claim or suspicion the tank has been removed or closed-in-place, but no documentation to support the claim. Administrative Abandon is a status that the department places on a tank that is obviously not in use, does not meet the “Temporarily-Out of-Service status and has not been legally closed (removed or closed-in place). Tanks that have been designated “Administratively Abandon” by the department will appear in the search for “Abandon” tanks. “YA” is the designator.
