Site reconnaissance indicated that two drums exist on site. Are these drums associated with the PECFA project and will the winning bidder be responsible for disposal?

The drums on-site are associated with the PECFA project and the winning bidder will be responsible for disposal.

The SI identified some wells with VOCs that are not included in the PVOC analysis. Should VOC testing continue in these wells and will it be considered part of the PECFA costs?

No, VOC testing does not have to be conducted.

There are indications on their maps that there is soil contamination in the vicinity of the removed Fuel Oil UST, but no specific compounds or metals typically associated with Fuel Oil USTs were tested for, and no additional borings were done in the area to determine the depth or lateral extent of the contamination. What criteria should be used to determine if and how much of the soils in this area require a remedial response?

A soil boring was taken near the fuel oil UST to a depth of 12.5 feet. There were no indications of contamination via PID or analytical analysis.

In the bid requirement, the Department is requiring testing for PAHs, however no PAH sampling was done during the site investigation. Should all wells be analyzed for PAHs or should PAH testing to be limited to those wells for which elevated DRO concentrations have been identified?

All wells will be analyzed for PAH parameters.
