Notes from April 28, 2004 pre-bid meeting/site visit: Only one consulting firm attended the meeting. The DNR project manager pointed out that the blower for the soil vapor extraction system on site at present is the property of the current consultant, and likely would not be available for use on this project by another consulting firm. The DNR project manager and the consultant walked the site and surrounding properties, and the consultant was able to observe the location of existing private and monitoring wells. The following question was generated from these observations.

- Q. Can the location of the first piezometer required in the Minimum Remedial Requirements of the Bid Document be modified to better reflect the locations of downgradient private wells?
- A. Yes, the piezometer should be installed in a location that best fits the site conditions. Please note that the DNR project manager shall approve the location of this piezometer prior to its installation.
