1) Is the waste soil or groundwater?

The waste is liquid, a mixture of groundwater and free phase petroleum.

2) What is the current schedule for bottled water to the Weckler property?

The Weckler home receives bottled water in 5-gallon containers. Fifteen gallons of water are delivered to the Weckler home every two weeks.

3) Who is the lender?

State Bank of Chilton.

4) Has any claim been filed?

Two claims have been filed.

5) If claims(s) is/are filed, is it possible to divide the site investigation and remedial costs?

The answer is unknown.

6) Will the Department provide the previous maps and tables on a disc to the hired successful bidder?

7) Is water stored in the drum?

The Department has been provided the following costs for bottled water service to the Weckler residence: \$5.25 per five-gallon bottle and \$9.00 per month for cooler rental.

10) How many gallons of bottled water will be supplied per week?
