Question:

All wells are to be sampled once, but the number of sampling points is unspecified

Answer:

Consultants are strongly encouraged to review the site documentation available at the Copy Shop prior to bidding. There are five existing monitoring wells plus one new one to be installed in this Bid Scope of Work for a total of six monitoring wells. In addition, there are two private wells to be sampled. The existing site monitoring wells are shown on the plan view maps included in the January 15, 2003 Summary Report for this site available at the Copy Shop

Question:

Is the interactive map on the DNR "GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites" and acceptable method for determining the GPS coordinates for this site?

Answer:

Preference is for accurate in-field GPS data taken during site a site visit for other purposes such as well installation or sampling. However, using the DNR interactive map is acceptable.

NOTE TO BIDDERS: This site is also known as the "Brush Hollow Cheese Factory - Former". The site documentation at the Copy Shop uses that name and it is listed on BRRTS with that name. When in doubt refer to the Comm and BRRTS numbers.
