Q. I have a question regarding the bid document for KC's Service in Prentice. The groundwater sampling program specifies VOCs, lead and NA parameters. Does this mean VOCs, lead and NA parameters must be collected from all monitoring wells associated with the site for each sampling event?

A. For the purposes of the bid response, prospective bidders should assume that all wells should be sampled for VOC, lead and natural attenuation parameters during each sampling round. This will allow for an “apples to apples” comparison of bid responses. The winning bidder can request that the Departments of Natural Resources and Commerce allow modifications to the sampling requirements once the project is initiated. Note that the Department of Commerce has indicated that VOC analysis will be eligible for reimbursement on this project.

Q. The minimum remedial requirements call for quarter-annual sampling of all wells for VOCs. Is it possible to collect VOC samples for the first round and for subsequent rounds sample for PVOCs, naphthalene and other VOCs detected in the first round to keep costs down?
