Q: If this site is owned by the Fox Valley & Western Railroad, does that mean the winning consultant will have to meet the railroad's standard \$5 million pollution liability specification in order to be retained?

A: Mr. Geoffrey Nokes of Fox Valley & Western (847-318-4648) advises that the remediation consultant and contractors will need to provide certificate of insurance coverage for accidents to FV&W. A Right of Entry Permit for Environmental Remediation will need to be executed. If work will be conducted 25 feet or less from mainline track, then a flagman will be required

Q: Also, you note that the site has an environmental factor--free product--but you make no mention of this in either the General Comments section or the Minimum Remedial Requirements section. Where was the free product detected, and, in any event, is it no longer considered to be problematic?

A: As noted in the bid specification free product is present. The site investigation report and addendum available to all bidders provides additional information regarding the occurrence of free product.
