Reason for Credential: Except as provided under s. 145.06 (4) Stats., and pursuant to s. 145.06, Stats., no person may install plumbing unless the person holds a credential issued by the department as a licensed master plumber, licensed master plumber-restricted, licensed journeyman plumber, licensed journeyman plumber-restricted, registered plumbing apprentice, registered plumbing learner-restricted, registered utility contractor or registered pipe layer. A person holding a journeyman plumber license may apply without examination for a POWTS inspector certification.

Requirements of Credential: The plumbing activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a credential as a licensed journeyman plumber shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who holds a master plumber license, master plumber-restricted license, or utility contractor license. A journeyman plumber who is working under the general supervision of a licensed master plumber-restricted or licensed utility contractor is limited to the type of plumbing installations associated with the specific license of the person providing the supervision. A person who holds the credential shall carry on his or her person the card issued by the department while performing or conducting the activity or activities permitted under the credential.

A business engaged in the installation of plumbing that utilizes plumbing learners shall maintain a ratio of at least one journeyman plumber or journeyman plumber-restricted for each plumbing learner. For this purpose, a master plumber or master plumber-restricted may act as a journeyman plumber or journeyman plumber-restricted, respectively.

Education Hours Required to Renew: The renewal of a license as a journeyman plumber shall be contingent upon the journeyman plumber obtaining at least 24 hours of acceptable continuing education three months prior to the expiration date of their credential. A person who holds a license as a journeyman plumber may apply to the department for waiver of the continuing education requirements on the grounds of prolonged illness or disability or similar circumstances. Each application for waiver shall be considered individually on its merits by the department.

If you pass the exam to obtain this credential, you will not be required to take any continuing education prior to your first expiration date. You will be required to fulfill the continuing education requirements starting after you have renewed your credential for the first time. If you obtain this credential by any other method, you will be required to fulfill the continuing education requirements at least 3 months prior to your expiration date.

Applying for Journeyman Plumber License

A person may obtain a credential as a licensed journeyman plumber by one of the following methods:

- Method 1 Completing an apprenticeship and taking and passing the journeyman plumber license examination.
- Method 2 Submitting evidence that the person possesses a journeyman plumber license-retiree.
- Method 3 A person who holds a master plumber license may, upon application to the department, exchange his or her master plumber license, for a journeyman plumber license. If the exchange is made at the time of renewal a credential fee of \$180 for the journeyman plumber license shall be submitted.

Special Processing Note: If you hold a current license from another state, or under the ordinances of any city, town or village, you must first complete a petition for variance in accord with SPS 305.90(4)(c) and (d), Wisconsin Administrative Code. Upon successful completion of the variance process, complete the examination application as specified in Method 1 and provide a copy of the petition approval correspondence.

Method 1 - Apprenticeship and Examination

Application and Exam Fee (nonrefundable): \$30.00 class code 7630

Make checks payable to: State of WI - DSPS. The fee consists of a \$10 application fee and an exam fee of \$20. When the exam is passed, the applicant will be asked to pay a \$180 license fee which will be prorated because the license expires on a specific date. The license, which is issued after the exam is passed and the prorated license fee paid, is effective for four years from March 31.

Qualifications for Examination: A person applying for a journeyman plumber license examination shall have completed a plumbing apprenticeship program recognized under ch. 106, Stats.

Attach to this form a photocopy of a letter from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards stating that you have satisfied the requirements of a plumbing apprenticeship program in order to take the exam and the program has been recognized by the department under ch. 106, Stats., and the federal Department of Labor. In order to obtain the credential the applicant must obtain a score of at least 70% on an examination. The exam will cover Chapter 145, Wisconsin Statutes; and chapters SPS 305 and SPS 382-87, Wisconsin Administrative Code; NFPA 13D-2002. The exam is open code book, component manuals, NFPA, and statutes.

Copies of current Wisconsin Administrative Code and Chapter 145 may be obtained from Document Sales, 608-266-3358 or 800-362-7253. The NFPA standards 13 (2002 edition) of the National Fire Protection Association may be ordered from the National Fire Protection Association, 800-344-3555.

You will need to have a working knowledge of the component manuals for the various POWTS. You may bring these to the exam site.
