# SUMMARY OF FINAL REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ANALYSIS

### Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis Summary

Pursuant to s. 227.19 (3m), Stats., the Department of Commerce has determined that the proposed rules to create chapter Comm 9 will not have a significant impact on a substantial number of small businesses. The proposed rules implement the mandates imposed by 2009 Wisconsin Act 390 regarding the anchoring or securing of movable soccer goals. The Department does not believe the rules will increase the effect on small businesses more than that imposed by the Act. The Department did not receive any comments by individuals indicating that they represented a small business.
