

DSPS Instructor

This is a half-day course designed for those who perform site management duties, supervise or direct construction activities, install best management practices, and/or inspect sites for compliance relating to erosion/sediment control and storm water management. Attendees who successfully complete the exam will be eligible to receive the Soil Erosion Inspector certification through the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DPS).

This 8-hr course is designed to educate attendees how to conduct renovating and remodeling activities in a lead-safe manner. Topics covered include background information on lead, health effects of exposure to lead, regulations, worksite preparation, conducting interim control and non-abatement activities, work site clean-up and disposal. This class satisfies the training requirement to become EPA certified as a Lead Safe Renovator.
