



# 2012 Winter Inspector Updates



Wisconsin's regional inspector associations, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services, Safety and Buildings Division, are offering training sessions in early 2012 about Wisconsin's Electrical Code, Uniform Dwelling Code, and Commercial Building Code. These courses can provide continuing education credits for S&B-administered inspection and DCQ credentials. Fire inspectors, designers, contractors, and others with an interest in Wisconsin's codes may also benefit from the programs.

**\*\*New for 2012\*\*** If you have a specific code question relating to the topics below, or a code is unclear to you, submit your questions and the sessions you plan to attend to S&B no later than 01/13/2012. (Credential abbreviations below are: CBI = Commercial Building, CEI = Commercial Electrical, UCI = UDC-Construction, UHI = UDC-HVAC, UEI = UDC-Electrical, DCQ = Dwelling Contractor Qualifier, ME = Master Electrician and JE = Journeyman Electrician).

**Commercial Electrical Code** - This course includes short programs on short circuit analysis and marking of service equipment, fire pump plan approval, and emergency lighting as well as Comm 16 (soon renamed SPS 316) and NEC 2011 code changes and Q&A on commercial electrical code topics. It is recommended that participants have the current Comm 16 and the NEC 2011 for this class. 6 con ed credit hours for CEI, UEI, ME, JE. Includes lunch at noon.

**UDC Electrical Code** - This course includes the Comm 16 (soon renamed SPS 316) and NEC 2011 code changes as well as Q&A on UDC electrical code topics. It is recommended that participants have the current Comm 16 and the NEC 2011 for this class. 6 con ed credit hours for CEI, UEI, ME, JE. Includes lunch at noon.

**Uniform Dwelling Code** - This course will cover the AWC Deck Code, wall bracing, duct design and construction, as well as Q&A and administrative issues. 6 con ed credit hours for UCI, UHI and DCQ. Includes lunch at noon.

**Commercial Building Code** - This course will focus on the 2009 I-Code changes as well as HVAC and energy issues including Ashrae 90.1, glazing, R-2 accessibility and administrative issues. It is recommended that participants have the 2009 I-Codes for this class. 6 con ed credit hours for CBI. Includes lunch at noon.

**Plumbing** - These courses are being offered separately through the association where listed on the registration form. Questions regarding these courses should be directed to the association's contact person. Includes lunch at noon.
