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# Dwelling Contractors

- Dwelling Contractor Certification – business credential  
One year term
  
- Dwelling Contractor Qualifier Certification – individual credential  
Two year term



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# Dwelling Contractors

## Contractor Qualifier:

- Responsible for education obligations
- Implemented on January 1, 2008



# Dwelling Contractors

## Dwelling Contractor and Qualifier Certifications

- Required to obtain a building permit for work on one- or two family dwelling – if not the occupant-owner
- s. 101.654, Wis. Statutes



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# Dwelling Contractors

Building Permits required:

- New One- or Two- Family Dwelling
- Additions or Alterations at the discretion of the municipality
- Excludes, electrical, plumbing or HVAC work

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# Dwelling Contractors

## Contractor Prerequisites:

- Liability insurance or bond
- Attest to compliance with worker's compensation and unemployment insurance requirements

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# Dwelling Contractors

## **Responsibilities include:**

- Not contract with another person or business unless they hold the appropriate business credential with Safety and Buildings.

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# Dwelling Contractors

## Qualifier Prerequisites:

- 12-hour approved course with tests (third party) covering:
  - Construction law
  - Construction codes
  - Construction business practices
- Renewal:
  - 12 hours of continuing education work

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# Building Contractors

**Construction business** that affects:

- Public Buildings
- Places of employment
- One and two family dwellings built since 12/01/78
- Public swimming pools and water attractions

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# Building Contractors

“**Construction business**” means a trade that installs, alters, or repairs any building component, material or device that is regulated under the commercial building code, chs. Comm 60 to 66, the uniform dwelling code, chs. Comm 20 to 25, the electrical code, ch. Comm 16, the plumbing code, chs. Comm 81 to 87, or the public swimming pools and water attractions code, ch. Comm 90.

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# Building Contractors

**“Construction business”**  
does not include the design of the structure, the delivery of building supplies or materials, or the manufacture of a building product not on the building site.



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# Building Contractors

**Exemptions - do not need the Building Contractor Registration if the entity holds any of these:**

- ❑ Dwelling Contractor Certification
- ❑ Dwelling Contractor- Restricted Certification
- ❑ Manufactured Home Dealer License
- ❑ Manufactured Home Installer License
- ❑ Manufactured Home Manufacturer License
- ❑ Electrical Contractor Certification
- ❑ Electrical Contractor – Restricted Certification
- ❑ HVAC Contractor Registration
- ❑ Elevator Contractor License

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
# Building Contractors

## Exemption:

A person or entity that works only on real estate or property they own or lease.



**I own a construction business\* that performs residential or commercial work in Wisconsin. Which contractor credential do I need?**



\* "Construction business" means a trade that installs, alters or repairs any building element, component, material or device that is regulated under the commercial building code, chs. Comm 60 to 66, the UDC, chs. Comm 20 to 25, the electrical code, ch. Comm 16, the plumbing code, chs. Comm 81 to 87, or the public swimming pools and water attractions code, ch. Comm 90. The term does not include the delivery of building supplies or materials, or the manufacture of a building product not on the building site.

\*\* "Manufactured home" means either a structure that is designed to be used as a dwelling with or without a permanent foundation and that is certified by the federal department of housing and urban development as complying with the standards established under 42 USC 5401 to 5425, or a mobile home, unless a mobile home is specifically excluded under the applicable statute.

\*\*\* Any person, entity or business that engages in or offers to engage in the business of constructing, installing, altering, servicing, replacing or maintaining conveyances must obtain an Elevator Contractor License, unless that person, entity or business only services or maintains existing conveyances within facilities or properties owned by the person, entity or business.

- \$100 credential fee if application completed online.
- \$115 credential fee if application is mailed.
- Approved for 4 years from the date issued.
- Attest to compliance with worker's compensation and unemployment insurance requirements.

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# Building Contractors

## **Responsibilities:**

- Include the BCR registration number on all construction bids and contracts.
- Not contract with another person or business unless they hold the appropriate business credential with Safety and Buildings.
- Cannot work on commercial projects where the municipality requires permits until the permit is obtained.
- If plan approval is required, cannot start construction until plan approval has been obtained
