



**Applying For Dwelling Contractor Qualifier Certification:** You may obtain a credential as a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier by submitting an application, application fee, credential fee and evidence of completing at least 12 hours in an approved initial qualifier course in dwelling construction within one year prior to the date of application.

**ATTACH** course provider verification that you have successfully completed an approved course and test.

**Education Hours Required to Renew:** The renewal of a certification as a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier shall be contingent upon the qualifier obtaining at least 12 hours of acceptable continuing education three months prior to the expiration date of their credential which is two years after the start date of your credential. A person who holds a license as a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier may apply to the department for waiver of the continuing education requirements on the grounds of prolonged illness or disability or similar circumstances. Each application for waiver will be considered individually on its merits by the department.
