Reason for Credential: Except as provided under s. 145.06 (4) Stats., and pursuant to s. 145.06, Stats., no person may install plumbing unless the person holds a credential issued by the department as a licensed master plumber, licensed master plumber-restricted, licensed journeyman plumber, licensed journeyman plumber-restricted, registered plumbing apprentice, registered plumbing learner-restricted, registered utility contractor or registered pipe layer.

Requirements of Credential: Pursuant to s. 145.14, Stats., the plumbing activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a credential as a licensed master plumber-restricted appliance, licensed journeyman plumber-restricted appliance, or registered plumbing learner-restricted appliance shall be limited to the installation and modification of water heaters, water softeners, water treatment devices and other items in connection with an existing water supply system which do not require direct connection to the drain system. A person who holds the credential shall carry on his or her person the credential issued by the department while performing or conducting the activity or activities permitted under the credential.

The plumbing activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a credential as a licensed journeyman plumber-restricted appliance shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who is a licensed master plumber or a licensed master plumber-restricted appliance. A business engaged in the installation of plumbing that utilizes plumbing learners shall maintain a ratio of at least one journeyman plumber or journeyman plumber-restricted for each plumbing learner. For this purpose, a master plumber or master plumber-restricted may act as a journeyman plumber or journeyman plumber-restricted, respectively.

Education Hours Required to Renew: The renewal of a license as a journeyman plumber-restricted appliance shall be contingent upon the journeyman plumber-restricted appliance obtaining at least 12 hours of acceptable continuing education three months prior to the expiration date of their credential. A person who holds a license as a journeyman plumber-restricted appliance may apply to the department for waiver of the continuing education requirements on the grounds of prolonged illness or disability or similar circumstances. Each application for waiver shall be considered individually on its merits by the department.

Applying for Journeyman Plumber - Restricted Appliance License

A person may obtain a credential as a licensed journeyman plumber-restricted appliance by one of the following methods:

- Method 1 Completing experience requirements, education requirements and taking and passing the journeyman plumber-restricted appliance license examination.
- Method 2 Submitting evidence that the person possesses a journeyman plumber-restricted appliance license-retiree.
- Method 3 A person who holds a master plumber-restricted appliance license may, upon application to the department, exchange his or her master plumber-restricted appliance license, for a journeyman plumber-restricted appliance license. If the exchange is made at the time of renewal a credential fee of \$180 for the journeyman plumber-restricted appliance license shall be submitted.

Special Processing Note: If you hold a current license from another state, or under the ordinances of any city, town or village, you must first complete a petition for variance in accord with SPS 305.90(4)(c) and (d), Wisconsin Administrative Code. Upon successful completion of the variance process, complete the examination application as specified in Method 1 and provide a copy of the petition approval correspondence.

Method 1 - Experience, Education and Examination

Application and Exam Fee (nonrefundable): \$30.00 class code 7630

Make checks payable to: State of WI – DSPS. The fee consists of a \$10 application fee and an exam fee of \$20. When the exam is passed, the applicant will be asked to pay a \$180 credential fee, prorated because the credential expires on a specific date. The credential, which will be issued after the exam is passed and the prorated credential fee paid, is effective for 4 years from March 31.

Qualifications for Examination: A person applying for journeyman plumber-restricted appliance license examination shall have at least 1,000 hours of experience as a registered learner-restricted appliance and submit evidence that they have completed at least the following educational course work:

- Plumbing code, chs. SPS 381 to 387 - 40 hours of credit;
- Blueprint or blueline reading - 20 hours of credit;
- Plumbing related mathematics - 10 hours of credit; and
- Appliance and equipment servicing - 30 hours of credit.

ATTACH to this form the original signed copy of the form entitled “Qualifications to Apply for Journeyman Plumber-Restricted Appliance Exam.” **Note if the form is not filled out and properly signed, you will not be allowed to take the examination.**

IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CREDENTIAL the applicant must obtain a score of at least 70% on an examination. The exam will cover Chapter 145, Wisconsin Statutes; and chapters SPS 305 and SPS 382-387, Wisconsin Administrative Code; NFPA 13D-2002. The exam is open code book, component manuals, NFPA, and statutes. When there is a change to Wisconsin Administrative Codes, exams will cover the new code one month after the effective date.

Copies of current Wisconsin Administrative Code and Chapter 145 may be obtained from Document Sales, 608-266-3358 or 800-362-7253. The NFPA standards 13 (2002 edition) of the National Fire Protection Association may be ordered from the National Fire Protection Association, 800-344-3555.

Additional training materials relating to this credential are available and may also be ordered through Document Sales, (608)266-3358 or 800)-62-7253. They are intended to be training guides and may not match the current code.

ATTACH a photocopy of your master plumber-restricted appliance license. Keep your original copy of your master plumber-restricted appliance license in case you decide to reacquire your master plumber-restricted appliance license at some future date.

Plumbing Learner-Restricted Appliance Instructions

To meet the qualifications to take the exam for the Journeyman Plumber-Restricted Appliance License, the person who holds the plumbing learner-restricted appliance registration must do the following prior to expiration of the plumbing learner-restricted appliance registration:

- accumulate 1,000 hours of experience as a plumbing learner-restricted appliance; and
- complete educational course work.

Both requirements must be met at the time of application for the journeyman plumber-restricted appliance exam.

The Plumbing Learner-Restricted Appliance registration is not renewable. Failure to complete the qualifications prior to the expiration date on the plumbing learner-restricted appliance registration will require the applicant to start over.

The Journeyman Plumber-Restricted Appliance exam contains many questions which are based upon the codes listed above. It is strongly recommended you purchase these codes. Note that Document Sales also offers an update service. If you purchase the update service, Document Sales will mail you copies of changes (if any occur) to the codes for which the update service was purchased for one year.

Educational Course Work

The master plumber you work for is responsible for your training and education. The documents in the Learner Packet include self checks so your understanding of the material can be verified. If you do not understand the material, you should ask the master plumber for help.
