

Manufactured homes in Wisconsin strongly affected by new law

State legislation that became law in October 2005 will have major effects on manufactured homes in the state. Aspects of 2005 Wisconsin Act 45 include the added authority for the state Department of Commerce (Safety and Buildings Division) to develop rules for manufactured home installations, licensing of installers, licensing of installation inspectors, and development of a dispute resolution system. Also part of the law are an increase in titling fees to administer a rehabilitation and recycling grant program, creation of a Manufactured Housing Code Council, and uniform installation standards, similar to Uniform Dwelling Code standards.

Bracing of garage wall returns will be considered in upcoming UDC code revision process

After discussing wind bracing requirements for garage wall returns with the Uniform Dwelling Code Advisory Council, Safety and Buildings Division staff have decided to wait until the next UDC revision process to decide a final course on the situation.

In early 2005, S&B told people at UDC inspector update sessions that there should be an enforcement emphasis on bracing requirements for garage door openings. Over time, as garage designs changed, code requirements of Comm 21.25(1)(b) had become less strictly enforced. S&B's announcement that stricter enforcement was appropriate was met with concern on a number of fronts and the division delayed the enforcement emphasis until January 2006.

Further discussion with people in the industry has not reached a consensus. S&B has decided to have the matter dealt with in the code development process.

The UDC is scheduled to be reviewed and considered for revisions in 2006.

More discussion of the subject will occur during the UDC inspection updates this winter.

A brochure on the inspection update sessions was mailed in mid-November to fire departments and people holding UDC, commercial, and electrical inspection certifications.

Licensing for HVAC installation?

Question: Does a person need an HVAC Contractor license to install heating, ventilating or air conditioning equipment in a dwelling that is occupied or currently under construction?


Answer: Yes, even if the person installing the equipment owns or occupies the dwelling or will occupy it after construction is complete. Comm 5.70(1)(a) states that "Pursuant to ss. 101.177 (2) and (3) (a) and 101.178 (2) , Stats, no person, entity or business may engage or offer to engage in the activity of installing or servicing heating, ventilating or air conditioning equipment except as provided in par. (b), ..." Exception (b) (1) states that "A person, entity or business is not required to hold a registration as a registered HVAC contractor to service existing heating, ventilation or air conditioning equipment or systems within

properties owned by the person or entity." Therefore, the exception does not apply to new installations.

Discussion: Section 101.178 (2), Stats., states that "No person may engage in the business of installing or servicing heating, ventilating or air conditioning equipment unless the person registers with the department." But, s. Comm 5.70(1)(a) Wisconsin Administrative Code, is more restrictive by stating that no person, entity of business may engage in the activity of installing the HVAC equipment. The only exception is the servicing of existing equipment within properties owned by the person or entity.
