
agencies in advance of starting work of code projects, in these cases involving scheduled updates of the two codes.

The plumbing code was last updated in 2004, mostly in terms of stormwater sections. The anticipated code work is to evaluate updating other plumbing requirements "to reflect changing technology and options."

The swimming pool portion of Chapter Comm 90 has remained essentially unchanged since at least 1994 when the public swimming pool program was transferred from the Department of Health and Family Services. This code project will evaluate updating the public swimming pool requirements "to reflect changing technology and options for design and installation." The target effective date for these revisions is the Spring of 2008.



CBRF Plan Review Pointers from DHFS

Community Based Residential Facilities (CBRF) require a state Department of Health and Family Services plan review to meet DHFS licensure requirements. Submit plans and specifications prior to construction to aid timely licensing of a facility. Project approval can be improved by making special effort to submit complete and scaled plans.

DHFS says one complete set with three cover sheets suffices as a submittal, with the correct application form accompanied by an appropriate fee. Application form DDE-2496 is for "Free-Standing" CBRF's and DDE-2333 is for CBRF's attached to a nursing home or hospital. 

Linear Loading Rates for Mounds

I was recently afforded the opportunity to review a number of mound plans and was surprised to see the number of designs that didn't correctly account for the linear loading rate restriction specified in all of the approved mound component manuals.

Let me address why the requirement is in the component manuals, where it is found, and how to properly meet it.

The intent of this requirement is to provide for adequate assimilation and treatment of effluent and prevent mound toe leakage when a restrictive soil horizon is present in the upper portion of the soil profile near the sand fill/in situ soil interface of the system. In table 1 of each component manual, a linear loading rate restriction of ≤ 4.5 gallons/foot/day is required for systems when in situ soil having a soil application rate of ≤ 0.3 g/sf/d occurs within 12 inches of fill material. The linear loading rate (LLR) is calculated by dividing the design wastewater flow (DWF) by the length of the dispersal cell (B): $DWF/B = LLR$. This

requirement promotes the “long and narrow” philosophy encouraged by many experts in the field. Notice that the calculation is not dependant on the number of laterals in the dispersal cell or whether or not the laterals are center-fed or end-fed. **Increasing the number of laterals in a dispersal cell does not change the linear loading rate.**

If the size of a lot prevents the installation of a longer mound, creating multiple dispersal cells will help meet this linear loading rate requirement, but the cells must be spaced much farther apart than the minimum three feet specified in the tables, in order to provide enough room for the effluent to move through the restrictive soil horizon before reaching the perimeter of the next dispersal cell.
