

# New law brings statewide enforcement of UDC

A new Wisconsin law requires the state's Uniform Dwelling Code be enforced in all municipalities. This includes the necessity to have new construction inspected for compliance with the UDC, the statewide building code for one- and two-family dwellings built since June 1, 1980.

The Home Safety Act signed into law by Governor Doyle on December 3, 2003, includes important changes to the enabling statutes for the UDC.

The changes were effective as of December 18, 2003. However, it will take three to six months to get the enforcement system into place.

Previous to the new legislation, municipalities with a population of 2500 or less could choose by resolution to decline UDC enforcement.

Those municipalities which previously chose to not enforce the UDC **now have three options:**

1. Adopt an ordinance to begin local enforcement of the UDC. This may include contracting with another municipality or a private party to do the work;

2. Delegate enforcement to their county, if the county is willing to accept it. Currently three counties have UDC enforcement programs, Adams, Chippewa, and Eau Claire);

3. Take no action - which then causes the Safety and Buildings Division to enforce the UDC for new homes in the municipality.

Currently, there are approximately 900 municipalities in Wisconsin which elected in the past to not enforce the UDC.

S&B plans to survey the municipalities that previously declined enforcement, to try to determine what the municipalities plan to do, so a system can be structured for S&B's enforcement responsibilities.

If enforcement options one or two are not chosen, S&B plans to contract out enforcement to registered UDC inspection agencies, either on a local or countywide basis.

It is anticipated that any bidding process for contracts for enforcement will take place in Spring 2004. Info on the status of setting up a new enforcement system will be in the *WCCR* and on the Web page noted above.

Keep in mind that UDC certified inspectors and inspection agencies may contract directly with the municipalities to provide enforcement.


Apprentices wear two hats while performing plumbing work.

The state Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards in the Department of Workforce Development sets requirements for apprentice's training and administers the indenture system. (Apprentices need to annually renew the ~~DXD~~ Commerce apprentice registration! Renewal notices are sent to apprentices.)

That apprenticeship indenture agreement does not do away with the need for an apprentice to maintain their plumbing registration with the Safety and Buildings Division of the Department of Commerce. The law [Chapter 145.06(1)(a)] says: "No person may act as a plumbing apprentice or pipe layer unless registered with the department." ## Electrical Q&A

1. Who is responsible for a "known" violation? A co-worker says that if the foreman instructs you to install something that you know is not right, then he is responsible. How would someone protect themselves if they're in a situation where they did not want to install unsafe electrical work?

**Answer:** The person doing the work is responsible. If someone tells you to speed and you get a ticket, who is at fault? Typically, the electrician in charge (journeyman) is responsible for the work on-site. Ultimately, the contractor/employer is responsible for the work of an employee. Disagreements should be discussed with your supervisor, foreman, or with the inspector. Companies have a chain of command similar to the military. If your's doesn't work, you could look for a different employer.

Wisconsin Statute 101.865 states: "It is hereby made the duty of every contractor and other person who does any electrical wiring in this state to comply with the Wisconsin State Electrical Code."

2. Say a condo building has an unheated garbage room, under a carport. It has a sprinkler system as required by the building code. A heat tape listed for fire protection systems protects those pipes to keep them from freezing. The NEC requires a GFI-protected receptacle for the heat tapes. If the GFI trips in very cold weather, the pipes could freeze, which would result in a flood. Ideas?



**Answer:** Section 427.22 requires ground fault protection of equipment (GFPE) for electric heat tracing. This is not the same as ground-fault circuit-interrupter (GFCI) protection designed to open a circuit when it senses a ground-fault of 4 to 6 milliamperes. GFPE devices generally trip at 30 milliamperes. If the ground-fault protection trips, there is a problem. NEC 422.50 requires cord and plug-connected pipe heating assemblies intended to prevent freezing of piping to be listed. When a sprinkler system is used and freezing could be an issue, a dry system may be used with an air compressor to maintain air pressure in the system. If a wet system is used, an alarm may be advisable.

# Rules headed to legislature that lengthen some credential terms and create a commercial plumbing inspector license

Miscellaneous code revisions to Comm 5, the Licenses, Certifications, and Registrations Code, were expected to be forwarded to the legislature for committee review. The expectation was as of the printing deadline of this *WCCR* in early December.

One of the revisions standardizes many Safety and Buildings Division credential terms at four years, where there previously had been terms of 1-3 years. Exceptions to the change of term are credential lengths set by statute (law) rather than code. Those terms not lengthening include plumbers, sprinkler installers, dwelling contractors, and petroleum tank credentials.

Fees and continuing education responsibilities are not increased, but will be adjusted to fit the new terms (if the rule revisions pass legislative scrutiny and are adopted by the Department of Commerce).

Other notable facets of the code package are new rules requiring certification of inspectors or

supervisors responsible for inspection of plumbing installations within first, second, and third class cities. The rules allow master and journeyman plumbers to be certified as commercial plumbing inspectors without examination.

## Plumbing Learner competency exams are discontinued

Competency exams for plumbing learners are no longer mandated by the Safety and Buildings Division. The competency exams until recently have been given by S&B staff or through tech schools. The material previously covered in the competency exams will be part of the journeyman-restricted exams.

In order to take those journeyman-restricted exams, learners will still need to complete course work and complete at least one thousand hours of

experience, as required by Comm 5.94, Licenses, Certifications and Registrations Code.

# Enrolled Commercial Building Code is updated

An up-to-date 2003 Enrolled *WCBC* is now available in a two-volume, ring-binder paper set, for \$200, and in a single-user, compact-disc electronic version for \$240.

There have been two *WCBC* revision packages since the Enrolled Code was originally printed in 2002, with one being effective past spring.

There are now two update sets of pages for the original paper 2002 version of the Enrolled Code, available for free download or for purchase (\$10 per set), <http://www.commerce.state.wi.us/SB/SB-CommercialBuildingsCodeObtain.html>.

The paper copies of the complete Enrolled Code, as of November 21, 2003, are complete new versions which do not need any update pages. (All CD copies of the Enrolled Code, no matter when purchased, are the latest versions and do not need any updating!)

As of November 21, 2003, the second paper printing of the Enrolled Code became available. The second paper printing differs from the original 2002 printing by incorporating code changes that became effective on July 1, 2002, and on May 1, 2003.

The **Wisconsin Enrolled Commercial Building Code** includes Comm 61 to 65 and adopted provisions of the International Code Council codes.

**Replacement Pages:** Any paper copies of the 2002 printing that were purchased before July 8, 2002, can be updated to match the latest, printing by obtaining a 2002 set of replacement pages and a 2003 set of replacement pages. Any paper copies of the 2002 printing that were received after July 8, 2002 and before November 21, 2003, (which did include the 2002 set of replacement pages) can be updated to match the latest printing by obtaining just the 2003 set of replacement pages. These two sets of replacement pages can be downloaded free on the S&B WebSite, or can be purchased using the order form below.

All CD copies of the Enrolled Code, no matter when purchased, are the latest versions, and do not need any updating!
