Question: We are building a 6-story hotel/condominium project and the building construction is Type II with metal studs. We have been told that nonmetallic sheathed cable (NM) (Romex) can be used in the metal stud walls of the units. Is this true?

Could we use electrical nonmetallic tubing (ENT) (smurf tube) for the installation?

Answer: No to the first question. Article 334 in the NEC covers the use of NM cable. Section 334.10 says that NM is permitted in (1) one and two-family dwellings; (2) multifamily dwellings of Types III, IV, and V construction, except as prohibited in 334.12; and (3) other structures permitted to be of Types III, IV, and V construction, except as prohibited in 334.12.

The second sentence in (3) is deleted in Comm 16. From here we go to Section 334.12(A) which says that Type NM cable shall not be permitted in any dwelling or structure not specifically permitted in 334.10(1), (2), or (3).

In addition 334.12 has a lengthy list of other types of occupancies and uses where NM is not permitted.

The installation of NM cable in a Type II building would be in violation of Article 334 of the NEC.

Yes to the second questions. Article 362 of the NEC covers Electrical Nonmetallic Tubing (ENT). Section 362.10 is Uses Permitted and allows ENT to be exposed or concealed in buildings not exceeding three floors above grade. In any building exceeding three floors above grade, the ENT shall be concealed within walls, floors, and ceilings where the walls, floors, or ceilings provide a 15-minute finish rating. The exception allows the use of ENT in these buildings exposed or concealed, where a fire sprinkler is installed in accordance with NFPA 13-2002.

ENT could be used in the Type II building you mention provided it is concealed by a 15-minute finish rating or the building is protected by fire sprinklers in accordance with NFPA 13 – 2002. There is no similar provision for the use of Type NM cable.

For example

Comm 81.01(176) (11/24/04) What is the definition of “process piping?”

Process piping is a system that conveys process water, potable water that has been altered or modified by the addition of a product, chemical, or ingredient such that the water has been degraded to where it would cause a nuisance, be aesthetically objectionable, or could cause minor damage. Drinking the water would not constitute a health hazard. For example: Water is potable to the point where the first ingredient is added to the water for brewing beer. From that point on the system is process piping.

Comm 81.01(176) 6/6/00 When is a depression in the floor considered plumbing?

When a grated trench is installed in a building it is considered a plumbing fixture and must be properly drained and disposed of as in 82.10(8). The only exception to this is when the depression or pit is a containment device for hazardous waste.

Comm 81.01(38) 5/26/98 The plumbing code definition of one building.

Two buildings become one when they touch or share a roofline. Individual units separated by a “division wall” and having individual sewers or water services can become separate buildings. For more information, see the description (*attached online*).

Delta combination water heaters recalled

Delta Performance or Delta Performance Plus Series combination water heaters have been recalled by Triangle Tube because of a possible carbon monoxide poisoning hazard.

Reportedly, the burner plate and flue hood seal on about 3,000 water heaters manufactured by Triangle Tube of Blackwood, NJ, from August 2001 to January 2006 can fail due to an improper seal, causing a leak of flue gases and carbon monoxide. This poses risk of carbon monoxide poisoning to consumers inside of the house.

The heaters were sold at plumbing and heating wholesale companies around the U.S. to independent plumbing and heating contractors for about \$3,500.

Consumers should stop using the water heaters and contact Triangle Tube to schedule a free repair.

ITT Water Technology recalled pumps that can be used for fire suppression systems

ITT Water Technology in August announced a voluntary recall of about 18,300 Goulds, Bell and Gossett, and Red Jacket Water Products brand pumps for fire suppression systems. The announcement said consumers should stop using the pumps immediately.

A mechanical part on these pumps was reportedly not fully tightened, which can lead to the pump failing during use.

The recalled pumps are general in purpose, but are sometimes used in fire suppression systems. The pumps can be identified by having Model NPE, NPO, MCC, MCS, SM or Series 3530 on their nameplate. Recalled pumps were manufactured between December 2005 and July 26, 2006. They have date code M05, A06, B06, C06, D06, E06, F06 or G06. The date code is the first three digits of the serial number on the pump nameplate.
