SELLER INSTALLING: If the seller is permanently installing the unit on the buyer's land (i.e., setting it on a foundation/blocks, connecting pipes, etc.), it is then considered a real property improvement and the <u>seller</u> is responsible for paying tax on 65% of **their cost for the mobile home.** If the seller is installing the unit on land not owned by the buyer (i.e. trailer park), it is then considered the sale of tangible personal property and the seller should charge the buyer tax on 65% of the total selling price of the unit.

SELLER DELIVERING ONLY: If the seller is only delivering the unit, then it is the sale of tangible personal property and the buyer is responsible for tax on 65% of the **selling price.**
