






Contestant and Second/Corner License Requirements

Per Wisconsin law for Unarmed Combat Sports, all Contestant licenses and Second/Corner licenses MUST be completed and issued the week before the event at the latest!

	Check the status of your license (under Health/Business Individual Credential/License Search) https://licensesearch.wi.gov/ .
CONTESTANT	
	Contestant Application entirely filled out (including Social Security Number)
	\$40 payment (Credit card form is part of application. Consider buying a pre-paid card if you do not have a debit or other card.)
	Physical Exam (part of application) under 180 days old and must include the EYE EXAM
	Separate Bloodwork (actual lab results for HIV, Hep B, and Hep C) under 180 days old
Debut fighters or those with an expired ID <u>must also</u> submit the following:	
	National ID Application (MMA) OR Federal ID Application (Boxing)
	Color photo (head and shoulders, no hat or glasses) in digital format and scans of two current IDs
	\$10 fee. Can be added to \$40 licensing fee above (Total \$50)

SECONDS/CORNERS

Must be licensed in advance and indicate who they are representing.

	Corner Application (including Social Security Number)
	\$40 payment (part of application)
