Unarmed Combat Sports Contestant License Requirements

All Contestant licenses <u>MUST</u> be issued no later than four (4) business days before the event. You are strongly encouraged to apply and upload all documentation one week before the event.



Check the status of your license (under Health/Business Individual Credential/License Search) https://licensesearch.wi.gov/.



<u>Contestant Application Information</u> Apply online in <u>LicensE</u>. If you do not have a social security number, <u>Form 1051</u> is required.



Pay the \$40.00 license fee online in <u>LicensE</u>.



Upload <u>Contestant Medical Examination Report</u> (with Eye Exam). The medical and eye exam <u>must</u> be under 180 days old.



Separate Bloodwork - Upload lab results for HIV, Hep B, and Hep C). Results <u>must</u> be under 180 days old.



Contact the Commission to verify you have a current Boxing Federal ID card or MMA National ID card,

- Apply for ID card and pay \$10.00 fee in <u>LicensE</u>,
- Upload head and shoulders photo (no hats/glasses), and
- Upload two (2) forms of identification.
