AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

- 1. Application for Late Renewal- If your credential has been expired more than 5 years, you must apply by late renewal after 5 or more years. Apply online via LicensE, https://license.wi.gov/.
- Fees (\$80.00) The total amount is for the \$55.00 credential fee plus a \$25.00 late fee. Pay online via LicensE.
- Experience Record (Form 2489) Provide a complete listing of experience during the time period you did not hold a current license in Wisconsin.
- Verification of Examination or Licensure (Form 475) To be completed by each state in which you have been issued a license or registration if you hold or have held a license or registration in another state. The certification form must be sent by the state directly to DSPS.
- 5. Applicant Appraisal Form for Late Renewal (Form 2490) References from 3 licensed professionals in your field who have personal knowledge of your current experience.
- 6. Continuing Education All professions, excluding Designer of Engineering Systems, require proof of continuing education completion.

Review Dates: Your application for late renewal will be presented to the Section for review when all required documents have been received. You must submit your application at least 2 weeks before the Board meets. You'll find a schedule of tentative Board meetings on the Department's website at http://dsps.wi.gov.
