INFORMATION TO CONSIDER REGARDING THE PSYCHOMETRIC TESTING SPECIALTY:

- “Psychometric test” means a procedure for measuring psychological, behavioral, or interpersonal characteristics in which a sample of an examinee’s behavior is obtained and **subsequently evaluated and scored using a standardized process.**
- Psychometric testing does **not** include a test instrument used solely to:
 - screen for problems,
 - assist in treatment planning,
 - clarify treatment goals,
 - plan for interventions,
 - monitor progress in treatment,
 - evaluate performance in education, **or** an **unstandardized** questionnaire, **unstructured** behavior sample, **or** training or training prepared by a teacher or trainer.
- Marriage and Family Therapists (MFTs) and MFT Training License holders may perform psychometric testing under the supervision of: (1) a licensed psychologist; **or** (2) a marriage and family therapist, licensed professional counselor, or licensed clinical social worker granted the psychometric specialty under Wis. Admin. Code § [MPSW 1.11\(5\)](#).
- A Marriage and Family Therapist may not use a testing instrument for diagnostic or assessment purposes unless he or she satisfies the educational requirements for performing psychometric testing without supervision under Wis. Admin. Code § [MPSW 1.11\(5\)](#).
