## INFORMATION REGARDING THE PSYCHOMETRIC TESTING SPECIALTY (Wis. Stat. § 457.033 and Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 1.11):

Psychometric test - means a procedure for measuring psychological, behavioral, or interpersonal characteristics in which a sample of an examinee's behavior is obtained and subsequently evaluated and scored using a standardized process. A person credentialed by the board may not use a testing instrument for diagnostic or assessment purposes unless he or she satisfies the requirements in Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 1.11(5).

Psychometric testing does **not** include a test instrument used solely to screen for problems, to assist in treatment planning, to clarify treatment goals, to plan for interventions, to monitor progress in treatment or an unstandardized questionnaire, unstructured behavior sample or a test used to evaluate performance in education or training or training prepared by a teacher or trainer.
