### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRECEPTORSHIP APPLICATION

- 1. The application must be completed by the preceptorship program administrator of the college, the chiropractor/preceptor, and the student/graduate chiropractor. If more than **one** chiropractor will be serving as a preceptor at the preceptorship practice, this form **must** be completed for each chiropractor preceptor.
- 2. The following requirements <u>must be met prior to submitting the application form (Wis. Admin. Code ch. Chir 9):</u>
  - The chiropractic college is approved by the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board.
  - The preceptorship program is an established component of the curriculum of the college.
  - The preceptorship program has been reviewed and approved by the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board.
  - The student who participates in the program must have met all requirements for graduation except for completion of the preceptorship period.
  - The chiropractor/preceptor may supervise no more than one student at any one time.
  - Certification that the preceptor is a faculty member of the college.
  - Verification that the chiropractor/preceptor's Wisconsin license is in good standing.

### **DEADLINE**:

The application must be filed with the Wisconsin Chiropractor Examining Board <u>at least 30 days prior</u> to the meeting date listed on the Department website in order for your application to be reviewed at that meeting. Meeting dates may be viewed at <u>dsps.wi.gov</u>. Select "BOARDS/COUNCILS," then "All Meetings Calendar."

Per Wis. Admin. Code § Chir 9.03(6) a list of the chiropractors in Wisconsin who will be acting as preceptors in the program must be provided to the Wisconsin Chiropractor Examining Board at least 45-days prior to every trimester or academic quarter. Please refer to Page 2 for reasons for termination of a preceptorship.
