Master's Degree Equivalency Curriculum Requirements (Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 14.01)

Applicants with a **Master's degree equivalency in Professional Counseling** must have at least 60 semester hours or 90-quarter hours of academic credit in counseling related courses. These must include:

Subsection I:

- At least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours academic credit in Supervised Practicum Counseling experience that includes all of the following:
 - Documented proof of a minimum of 100 hours of supervised practicum experience with at least 40 hours face-to-face client contact.
 - One (1) hour per week of individual or triadic supervision throughout the practicum by a program faculty member, and approved student supervisor, or a site supervisor.
 - An average of 1 ½ hours per week of group supervision that is provided on a regular schedule throughout the practicum by a program faculty member or student supervisor.
 - At least six (6) semester hours or eight (8) quarter hours of academic credit in a supervised internship counseling experience that has all of the following:
 - O Documented proof of a minimum of 600 hours of supervised internship experience with at least 240 hours of face-to-face client contact.
 - One (1) hour per week of individual or triadic supervision throughout the internship performed by the onsite or field supervisor.
 - An average of 1 ½ hours per week of group supervision that is provided on a regular schedule throughout the internship by a program faculty member or a student supervisor.
- At least one course of at least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours academic credit in Counseling Theory.

Subsection II:

• At least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours academic - must have at least one course in each of the eight (8) content areas listed Subsection II below.

Subsection III:

• At least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours in one of the following content areas listed below.

Subsection IV:

At least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours in one of the following content areas listed below.

Subsection V:

• At least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours - must have at least one course in each of the four (4) content areas listed Subsection V below.

The remaining hours of academic credit must also be listed under the content areas into which they fit. To qualify, you must list at least 60 semester hours or 90-quarter hours total academic credit per Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 14.01.

Doctoral Degree Equivalency Curriculum Requirements (Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 14.02)

The doctoral program must consist of a minimum of 4 academic years of graduate-level preparation defined as 8 semesters or 12 quarters with a minimum of 96 semester credits or 144 quarter credits of graduate-level credits required of all students in the program. These must include a minimum of one course of at least three (3) semester hours or four (4) quarter hours academic credit in each of the content areas below. The remaining 36 semester hours or 54-quarter hours of academic credit must also be listed under the content areas into which they fit per Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 14.01.
