## CREDENTIALING INFORMATION FOR ACUPUNCTURIST **CERTIFICATION APPLICANTS**

For Certification as an Acupuncturist, fees and your application for certification as an Acupuncturist must be completed in LicensE.

### In addition, the following documents are required:

- 1. Evidence of successful completion of clean needle technique course sent directly to the Department from Council of Colleges of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (CCAOM).
- Evidence of successful completion of course of study and residency, the equivalent of at least two (2) consecutive years of full-time education and clinical work in Oriental diagnostic and therapeutic theories and practices at a school accredited by the National Accreditation Commission for schools, and colleges of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine or the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM). This must include dates attended and number of hours completed in program. Transcripts must be sent directly to the Department from the school.
- Evidence of successful completion of NCCAOM examination in acupuncture, with a passing score, determined by NCCAOM, sent directly to the Department from NCCAOM.
- Verification of Certification (active or inactive) as an acupuncturist in other state or territory, sent directly to the Department from state board(s). (If applicable.)
- 5. Affidavit of Active Acupuncture Practice (Form #2773). (Only required for reciprocal applicants or for late renewal after 5 or more years.)

NOTE: All supporting documents must be received directly from the jurisdictions and institutions involved. Documentation will not be accepted from the applicant.
