INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM TESTER LEARNER APPLICATION

Requirements for Credential

Per [Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.50](#), pursuant to [Wis. Stats. § 145.15 \(4\), 145.165 and 145.175](#), no person may install, maintain or repair automatic fire sprinkler systems unless the person holds a license or registration issued by the Department as a licensed Automatic Fire Sprinkler Contractor, a licensed Journeyman Sprinkler Fitter, a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Apprentice, a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler Contractor Maintenance, or a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler Fitter Maintenance. A credential is not required if a person is repairing, replacing or maintaining electrical supervisory devices for existing automatic fire sprinkler systems.

No person may conduct the annual activities relative to inspection and testing of an existing automatic fire sprinkler system and components as required by [Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 314](#) unless the person holds a license or registration issued by the Department as a licensed Automatic Fire Sprinkler Contractor, a licensed Journeyman Sprinkler Fitter, a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Apprentice, a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler Contractor Maintenance, a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler Fitter Maintenance or a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Tester or a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Tester Learner.

Per [Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.57](#), the automatic fire sprinkler system tester activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a registration as a registered Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Tester Learner shall be performed under the direct supervision of a person who holds an Automatic Fire Sprinkler Contractor license, a Journeyman Automatic Fire Sprinkler Fitter license, or an Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Tester registration.

AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

1. **Application and Fee:** The fee consists of a \$15 application fee and a \$15 credential fee, based on a 1 year term from the date of issuance.
2. **Qualification for Registration:** A person applying for an Automatic Fire Sprinkler System Tester Learner registration shall be at least 16 years old.
3. **Education:** The applicant shall have completed the 12th grade in high school or its equivalent. **Attach** one of the following:
 - A copy of your high school diploma
 - Evidence of completion of the general equivalency diploma
 - Notarized transcripts or letter from the high school stating you completed 12th grade
 - Transcripts showing you have a bachelor, associate or other degree from an accredited college or university

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APPLICATION FOR AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM TESTER LEARNER REGISTRATION

The Department must deny your application if you are liable for delinquent state taxes, UI contributions, or child support (Wis. Stat. §§ 440.12 and 440.13).
