## CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL ASSEMBLY TESTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION INFORMATION

### **Requirements for Credential**

Per <u>Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.99</u>, pursuant to <u>Wis. Stats. § 145.06(3m)</u>, no person may conduct a performance test of a cross connection control assembly as required by <u>Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 382.22(8)</u> unless the person holds a registration issued by the Department as a registered Cross Connection Control Assembly Tester. (Note: Effective 10/1/2023, the word "assembly" is contained in the credential name.)

#### AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

- 1. <u>Application and Fees</u>: Apply and pay fees online in LicensE, <u>https://license.wi.gov</u>. Fees will be calculated in LicensE. If needed, you can save your application and complete and submit it later. NOTE: If DSPS requests additional documents they must be uploaded within three (3) months from the date they were requested. Failure to do so may result in having to submit a new application and pay fees.
- 2. <u>Education</u>: A minimum of one of the following is required.
  - A. At least 40 hours in a Department approved course or courses in the theory of cross connection control, the operation, testing and maintenance of the cross connection control assemblies, and the national standards for these cross connection control assemblies (Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.99(3)(am)).
  - B. An American Society of Sanitary Engineering (<u>ASSE</u>) approved course meeting standard ASSE 5150 (Wis. Admin. Code § <u>SPS</u> <u>305.99(3)(bm)</u>).

**Upload** verification of completion of an approved Cross Connection Control Assembly and Backflow Prevention Course.
