INSTRUCTIONS FOR JOURNEYMAN PLUMBER APPLICATION

Requirements for Credential

Per Wis. Stat. § 145.06, no person may engage in or work at plumbing in the state unless licensed to do so by the Department.

Per Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.93, the plumbing activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a credential as a licensed Journeyman Plumber shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who holds a Master Plumber license, Master Plumber Restricted license, or Utility Contractor license. A Journeyman Plumber who is working under the general supervision of a licensed Master Plumber Restricted or licensed Utility Contractor is limited to the type of plumbing installations associated with the specific license of the person providing the supervision.

AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

A person may obtain a credential as a licensed Journeyman Plumber by one of the following methods:

Method 1 – WI Apprenticeship and Examination

Completing an apprenticeship and passing the Journeyman Plumber license examination.

- 1. <u>Application and Fee</u>: The fee consists of a \$10.00 application fee and a \$20.00 exam fee. When the exam is passed, the applicant will pay a \$180.00 prorated credential fee, based on a 4-year term from March 31st.
- 2. Plumbing Apprenticeship: A person applying for a Journeyman Plumber license examination shall have completed a plumbing apprenticeship program recognized under Wis. Stat. ch. 106 or the Federal Department of Labor. Attach a copy of a letter from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards stating that you have satisfied the requirements of a plumbing apprenticeship program in order to take the exam. If you have any questions about apprenticeship standards, please contact the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards at: http://dwd.wisconsin.gov/apprenticeship/contacts.htm or (608) 266-3332.
- 3. **Examination:** Select an exam date on Page 3. For additional information on exam content, please view the Department website at http://dsps.wi.gov under "Professions" and select "Journeymen Plumber."

Method 2A - Comity (Out-of-State) and Examination

Completing an apprenticeship and passing the Journeyman Plumber license examination.

- 1. <u>Application and Fee</u>: The fee consists of a \$10.00 application fee and a \$20.00 exam fee. When the exam is passed, the applicant will pay a \$180.00 prorated credential fee, based on a 4-year term from March 31st.
- 2. Plumbing Apprenticeship: A person applying for a Journeyman Plumber license examination shall have completed an out of state plumbing apprenticeship 5-year program, including plumbing related instruction of a minimum of 576 hours, recognized under Wis. Stat. ch. 106 or the Federal Department of Labor. Attach a copy of certificate of completion or equivalency from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards stating that you have satisfied the requirements of a plumbing apprenticeship program in order to take the exam. If you have any questions about apprenticeship standards, please contact the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards at: http://dwd.wisconsin.gov/apprenticeship/contacts.htm or (608) 266-3332.
- 3. Examination: Select an exam date on Page 3. For additional information on exam content, please view the Department website at http://dsps.wi.gov under "Professions" and select "Journeymen Plumber."

Method 2B - Comity (Out-of-State) and Examination

Completing an apprenticeship, passing the Journeyman Plumber license examination, and practiced for at least five (5) years under a journeyman plumber's license or equivalent license issued by another state.

- 1. **Application and Fee:** The fee consists of a \$10.00 application fee and a \$20.00 exam fee. When the exam is passed, the applicant will pay a \$180.00 prorated credential fee, based on a 4-year term from March 31st.
 - The Department shall accept for a journeyman plumber's examination a person to whom all of the following apply:
 - (a) The person completed a plumbing apprenticeship under Wis. Stat. § 106.025 or under the laws of any other state. Attach copy of certificate of completion of plumbing apprenticeship.
 - (b) The person passed a journeyman plumber's examination in any other state. (See Examination Table: Method 2B (b).)
 - (c) The person has practiced for at least five (5) years under a journeyman plumber's license or equivalent license issued by another state having licensure provisions governing plumbers that the department determines are substantially similar to the requirement under this chapter and the rules promulgated under this chapter, and the person has not been the subject of any disciplinary actions related to that license or any other equivalent license. (See Experience Table: Method 2B (c).)

Method 3 - Wisconsin Master Plumber License to be exchanged for a Journeyman Plumber License

A person who holds a Wisconsin Master Plumber license may, upon application to the Department, exchange his or her current Master Plumber license for a Wisconsin Journeyman Plumber license.

- 1. Application and Fee: The fee consists of a \$180.00 prorated credential fee, based on a 4-year term from March 31st. The fee table on Page 1 includes both the application fee and prorated credential fee. If the exchange is made at the time of renewal, a credential fee of \$180.00 for the Journeyman Plumber license shall be submitted.
- 2. Master Plumber License: Attach a copy of your Master Plumber license. Keep your original copy of your Master Plumber license.
