Draft letter to Madison Campus Pre-licensure BSN Students

Dear Nursing Student:

You may have noticed a recent change to the University catalog and website language associated with your campus. The purpose of this communication is to assure you that there has been no change in status of the accreditation of your pre-licensure BSN program, which continues to be in good standing with the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and approved by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (WBON). My intent is simply to provide clarity around the minor changes in catalog and website language.

As an institution comprised of seven campuses in nine states, our accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission requires the identification of a main campus. Herzing University's main campus is located in Madison, Wisconsin. Herzing University's institutional accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission has been associated with the Madison campus since 2004.

For regulatory purposes, delivery of online instruction is typically associated with the University's main campus. Herzing University delivers a post-licensure RN-BSN program as well as MSN and post-master's certificate nursing programs online. Each of these programs are accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE); this programmatic accreditation is associated with the University's main campus in Madison, Wisconsin.

Since the delivery of the online nursing programs is associated with the main campus—Madison, Wisconsin-- some minor changes in language have occurred in the catalog and on the website. Since you are enrolled in a nursing program on the University's main campus, I wanted to raise your awareness about these changes.

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Draft letter to Online RN-BSN, MSN and Post-master's Certificate Students

Dear Nursing Student:

You may have noticed a recent change to the University catalog and website language associated with nursing programs that Herzing University delivers online. The purpose of this communication is to assure you that there has been no change in status of the accreditation of your program, which continues to be in good standing with the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). My intent is simply to provide clarity around some minor changes in catalog and website language.

As a student enrolled in a fully online program, you may not be aware that the delivery of online instruction is typically associated with the University's main campus; Herzing University's main campus is located in Madison, Wisconsin. Herzing University's institutional accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission has been associated with the main campus since 2004. Similarly, specialized accreditation of fully online programs is typically associated with the main campus. The RN-BSN, MSN and post-master's certification programs are all accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE); this programmatic accreditation is associated with the University's main campus in Madison, Wisconsin.

In the profession of nursing, regulation is an important component to ensure safe and competent practice. The regulation of nursing education is equally complex and important to the safety and well-being of the public. Consequently, the University recently undertook steps to attain approval by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (WBON) to deliver online graduate nursing programs, since our main campus is located in Wisconsin. Previously, graduate programs were not regulated by the WBON. It is important to note that RN-BSN program was previously approved by the WBON.

There has been no change to the accreditation status of the RN-BSN, MSN or post-master's certificate programs. This communication is simply to provide you with the context for recent changes in the language that appears on the Herzing University website and in the catalog.
