
# Arizona College of Nursing (AZCN) Clinical Site Accessibility Maps

### **About CENE**

- CENE addresses systemic barriers and disparities in nursing education and advocate for policies that support equitable access to quality education and healthcare
- Predatory nursing schools have no place in Wisconsin
  - AZCN sued in three states, RED ALERT!
  - 800+ residents signed a petition rejecting AZCN
  - Elected officials issue warning on predatory schools
  - AZCN is not right for Wisconsin

### Farthest AZCN Milwaukee Clinical Site Map




#### DATA

- 29 Proposed clinical sites
- Over half are outside the City of Milwaukee
- Location distances are as far as 50 miles from AZCN's college building

#### **MAP KEY**

- House Icon: Location of the college's Milwaukee campus
- Location Icon: The proposed clinical site locations for AZCN students
- Green Rectangle: Farthest clinical sites proposed



## Public Transportation Distances from AZCN to Clinical Sites Map

The majority of the proposed clinical sites closest to Milwaukee:

 Average over 30 minutes from AZCN's campus


With many sites being over 30 minutes to clinicals, the campus and majority of sites are hard to access by public transport.

## Distances From City of Milwaukee to Clinical Sites Via Public Transportation

The majority of the proposed clinical sites closest to Milwaukee:

Average 40 minutes from Milwaukee to AZCN clinical sites

With many sites being over 40 minutes to clinical sites, the **majority of sites** are hard to access by public transport.

**Red:** Routes from AZCN campus to clinical sites

House: AZCN College Campus

Orange: Routes from Milwaukee to clinical sites

Green Stars: City of Milwaukee



## Social Vulnerability Map of AZCN Clinical Sites in Milwaukee, WI

Milwaukee County has a score of **0.8276**, which indicates a **high level of vulnerability**.

**Over half** of clinical sites proposed would be in Milwaukee County. Potential students, communities, and clinical sites face:

- High levels of poverty
- Lack of access to transportation
- Crowded/Segregated housing
- Lack of health insurance

### MAP KEY

Purple Dots: Sized to represent number of clinical sites in each County

## Summary

- AZCN proposed clinical sites are not accessible
- AZCN has inadequate plans supporting students socially vulnerable communities
- AZCN is a <u>predatory school</u> not worthy to operate in WI
- Poor students and students <u>from racial and ethnic</u>
   populations will be disproportionately impacted by AZCN
- The WI Board of Nursing should reject AZCN's
  application by denying their request to operate in WI
