

Phar 17.02 Definitions. In this chapter:

(2) “Direct supervision” means immediate on premises availability to continually coordinate, direct and inspect at first hand the practice of another.

(4) “Intern” means a person completing a internship in order to meet the requirement under s. 450.03 (2) (b), stats. It does not include a person practicing pharmacy pursuant to s. 450.02 (1) (f) or (g), stats.

(9) “Supervising pharmacist” means a pharmacist who supervises and is responsible for the actions of an intern in the practice of pharmacy.

Phar 17.035 Internship. (1) The intern is limited to performing duties constituting the practice of pharmacy under the direct supervision of a supervising pharmacist.

(2) The supervising pharmacist shall keep a written record of the hours and location worked by an intern under his or her supervision, signed by the intern and the supervising pharmacist. The written record shall be disclosed to the board upon request.

(3) Upon completing a maximum of ____ hours of the practice of pharmacy, in a postgraduate internship, the internship is terminated and the person shall not further engage in the practice of pharmacy until obtaining licensure from the board.
