Physical Therapy Licensure Compact Implementation:

- The Department, in coordination with the PT Compact, actively worked to implement and update Compact related operational processes.
- The Department sends licensure data at least weekly to the FSBPT's Exam, Licensure and Disciplinary Database (ELDD), an important informational database and tool for improving the cross-jurisdictional sharing of information.

Licensing Update:

- The Department improved its professional licensing capacity on several fronts:
 - Review time for new applications dropped to three days on average.
 - Review time on applications referred for legal evaluation dropped from a sixweek average processing time in 2022 to a two-week average processing time in 2023.

- Initial and renewal PTs and PTAs may now apply through LicensE, the new, selfguided online application system.
- A public facing dashboard was created to help improve transparency around licensing and department processing capacity.
- Training opportunities were provided to schools and educators.
- Instructional resources were completed and posted online.
