### **General Plumbing Classroom Courses**

### Stormwater

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, MPRS, JPRS, UC and Comm PI. Course is instructed by current DSPS staff.

This continuing education course will cover storm water drainage systems. This course will include the plan review requirements, checklists, sizing based on GPM load, types of systems to comply with NR 151 Standards, (detention, retention, infiltration, 1004 Standard), soil reports,(1002 Standard), and inspection practices.

### **Plumbing Topics**

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, UDC PI and Comm PI. Course is instructed by current DSPS staff.

This continuing education course will cover an array of topics throughout Chapter SPS 382. This course will be geared mainly at code questions, asked by you, that have been addressed by the department over the past year or so, along with the Department's responses.
