


Filing a Mines, Explosives, Fireworks Incident Report in eSLA



The following are a series of screen prints to aid the user in submitting a Mines, Explosives, Fireworks Incident Report.

In order to complete the process as quickly as possible, have names of those involved, related photos and any associated reports readily available for upload.

First: Sign in to eSLA, select New Application.


