DSPS Attorney Sarah Norberg Honored as a 2023 Legal All-Star

Milwaukee, Wis. – The Wisconsin Law Journal honored 29 Legal All-Stars on Wednesday afternoon in downtown Milwaukee.

"Sarah's work was instrumental in the improvements in legal review times," said DSPS Chief Legal Counsel Al Rohmeyer. "Her ability to identify the changes that needed to be made and advocate to see those changes through are worthy of this recognition."
