

The department may rescried on approval of an education course for any of the following reasons: false statements made in application, unicepresentation in application, false statements in course content, misrepresentation in course content, and falsification of attendance records. The division may rescind an approval of a course at any time, but not less than 50 days great the course scheduled date.

Special Examination Requirements: For certain types of education approvals, we require that you administer an examination to attendees as follows:

- Face-to-face Dwelling Contractor Qualifier and Manufactured Home Installer minal training Course provider to test offendees on university of course content.
- All non-face-to-face trining Minimum 10 review questions per hour with a passing score of 70%

- SPS305.71 (1) HVAC qualifiers. GENERAL. (a) Pursuant to s. 101.178 (3), Stats., an individual "may" obtain in accordance with this section an HVAC qualifier certification from the department relative to the business of installing or servicing heating, ventilating or air conditioning equipment.

- Exemption at local authority

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






Details of a Fillet Weld


