



Boiler Systems FAQs

1. Are Canadian-built boilers allowed to be used in Wisconsin?

Answer: Yes, as long as they meet the requirements of Canadian standard CSA B51. The Manufacturers Data Report (MDR) for that boiler should be reviewed.

2. I want to build my own boiler and use it to heat my business building and provide steam or hot water for my process. Can I build my own boiler and use it?

3. Can someone build and operate a 2-inch scale hobby boiler in Wisconsin?
