NFPA has several on-line Training Programs that we thought might be of interest as people are trying to maintain their training, especially during this time of “lock down”.

**NFPA 70E Online Course Series.** Hundreds of worker deaths and thousands of injuries could be prevented each year by following the latest edition of NFPA 70E, *Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace®*. Originally developed at OSHA's request, NFPA 70E provisions are applied to identify electrical safety hazards and reduce employee exposure to those hazards. **NFPA 80: Standard for Fire Doors and Other Opening Protectives.** Locate, interpret, and correctly identify and apply the requirements for the inspection, testing, and maintenance of fire door assemblies.
