### Liquefied Gas Supplier License FAQs

**1. Does a person holding a Liquefied Gas Supplier License have to operate its delivery vehicles and storage tanks with the name on the license as recorded with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services?**

**A:** No, the names used by the company to operate do not have to match the name recorded as holding the license. However, it is helpful to all involved to have some license identification closely available to Department staff or other interested parties as to what license the equipment is being operated under. The Department maintains a list of all licensed LP suppliers. This list is accessible through the Department's [License Look-Up](#) to aid in identifying properly-licensed companies.

**2. Does a supplier have to post their license number at their bulk sites?**

**A:** No however, the Department recommends posting a sign or placard with the Liquefied Gas Supplier License number at bulk sites to assist in providing identification to inspectors and other parties.
