

Subject: 2017 Wisconsin Act 329 Corrected

Yesterday, Governor Walker signed the following legislation into law.

The 2017 Wisconsin Act 329 alters the duration requirement of the Department conducting soil erosion control audits in each city, village, town or county from once every three years to once every five years. The Department is required to conduct soil erosion control audits for each city, village, town or county per Wis. Stats. § 101.653(5)(b)2. These audits are completed by members from the UDC team at the Department.

While the Act changes the duration of audits conducted by the Department, the Department will still continue the self-verification of soil erosion control plans through its generated online survey. The Department will also continue to conduct in person office and field audit as necessary.
