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FINDINGS

1. On January 15, 2026, the Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration published its final rule in the Federal Register listing 4-fluoroamphetamine in schedule I of the federal Controlled Substances Act. The rule is effective as of February 17, 2026.
2. The Controlled Substances Board did not receive an objection to similarly listing 4-fluoroamphetamine in schedule I under ch. 961, Stats. within 30 days of the date of publication in the federal register of the final order listing 4-fluoroamphetamine as a schedule I controlled substance.
3. The Controlled Substances Board will promulgate a final rule, without making the determinations or findings required by ss. 961.11(1), (1m), (1r) and (2) or s. 961.13 and omitting the notice of proposed rulemaking, listing 4-fluoroamphetamine as a schedule I controlled substance.

ORDER

Pursuant to s. 961.11(4), Stats., the Controlled Substances Board by affirmative action similarly treats 4-fluoroamphetamine under chapter 961, Stats. by creating the following:

**CSB 2.017 Addition of 4-fluoroamphetamine to Schedule I.** Section 961.14 (7) (v), Stats., is created to read:

**961.14 (7) (v).** 1-(4-fluorophenyl)propan-2-amine, commonly known as 4-fluoroamphetamine, para-fluoroamphetamine, or 4-FA.

This order shall become effective upon publication in the Administrative Register. The order expires upon promulgation of a final rule.
