Dear Mr. Deignan:

I am pleased to inform you that the Town of Geneva has been certified to do plan review and inspection in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code, Section ILHR 50.21. The Town of Geneva will have total responsibility for review and inspection of all new buildings and structures containing less than 50,000 cubic feet total volume, and alterations to buildings containing less than 100,000 cubic feet total volume. Drawings, specifications and calculations submitted to the Town of Geneva for examination and approval need not be submitted to the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations (DILHR). The buildings must be located within the limits of the Town of Geneva.

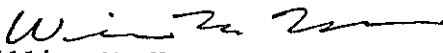
An exception to submission requirements would be buildings and structures owned by the State of Wisconsin. Drawings, specifications and calculations must be submitted to DILHR for examination and approval of these buildings and structures.

I understand that Independent Inspections of Wisconsin, Inc. will be doing all the plan review and inspections. They currently retain certified Commercial Building Inspectors and are authorized to do this type of work.

We will begin work on a press release announcing the Town of Geneva's participation in this program so that practicing engineers, architects and contractors will know that they no longer need to submit these projects to DILHR.
