Dear Mr. Krasny:

I am pleased to inform you that your municipality has been certified in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code, s. ILHR 50.21, for commercial building code enforcement. Your municipality will have primary responsibility for review of building and heating plans for all new commercial buildings of less than 50,000 cubic feet total volume and alterations involving less than 100,000 cubic feet volume. Building plans for such buildings that are located within your municipality should no longer be submitted to our agency.

Your municipality will also be responsible for inspecting only those buildings within the above certified municipality size limits. If you desire, you may have your municipal authorization amended to include the inspection, in lieu of the state, of all commercial building projects, regardless of size.

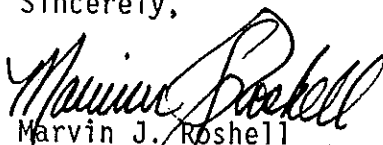
An exception to the above is that our agency retains jurisdiction for plan review and inspection authority for all state-owned buildings.

I understand that David Billmeyer will be in charge of plan review and inspections. This inspector is currently authorized to do this as a certified commercial building inspector. We do require that inspectors attend DILHR approved continuing education to maintain their certification.

We will begin work on a press release announcing this action so that building designers will know where to submit plans. Our inspection deputy for the area will be meeting with your inspector to discuss our procedures for state inspections in certified municipalities.

The Division of Safety and Buildings looks forward to working with you.
