Re: St. Croix County Health and Human Services Department Jurisdiction Request for Manufactured Home Community Licensing and Regulation

Dear Robert Rohret,

I am pleased to inform you that your agency has been delegated manufactured home community regulation authority. Per Wis. Stat. § 101.935(2)(e), the Department of Safety and Professional Services (The Department) delegates your agency the primary responsibility to issue permits to manufactured home communities within the limits of St. Croix County. In addition, you are delegated the responsibility to perform inspections of manufactured home communities for the situations provided under Wis. Stat. § 101.935(2m).

The Department may, with notice, inspect a manufactured home community whenever the Department determines an inspection is appropriate.

As a condition of the delegation, you are required to comply with the following:

- Issue permits to manufactured home communities in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.935(2)(a).
- Conduct at least one Routine Inspection each fiscal year (July 1 – June 30) of every manufactured home community within your agency's jurisdiction.
- Submit on an annual basis, [Form SBD-5524-E](#), Reimbursement of State Fees from Agents, and the appropriate fees, to the Department.
- Electronically submit to the Department, on an annual basis, the [Agent Report](#) roster (.xlsx file) to identify manufactured home community permits within your jurisdiction.
- Notify the Department, in writing, at least 90 days prior to the date upon which your agency intends to relinquish the delegated responsibilities assumed under this section.
- Apply the corresponding delegated agent requirements included in the [Requirements for Delegated Health Departments](#) document.

Please note that your submitted Manufactured Home Inspection Policy, Section II, Paragraph 11, specifies that the inspector is to make suggestions for improvement. Note that an inspector's responsibility is to identify violations to the code. Suggestions incorrectly implemented may become the responsibility of the inspector.

The Department will periodically monitor or audit agencies and request activity reports to ensure that the delegated responsibilities are being properly fulfilled by your agency. The Department requires that manufactured home communities are regulated under the jurisdiction of a local health department.

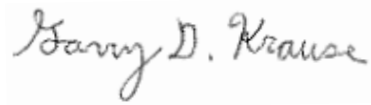
The Department will be implementing a five-year electronic renewal process. Please continue to monitor Department correspondence as further details regarding this process are communicated.
