- 3. <u>Registration with the Department of Financial Institutions</u> Only LLCs, LLPs, Corporations, and Foreign Corporations must meet this requirement.
- 4. <u>Peer Review</u> Submit peer review if licensed more than three (3) years in another state and performing attest services.
