 - **RE:** Manufactured Home Community License Requirements

Following is an outline of the requirements needed to obtain a new Manufactured home community license or to expand a current facility. Please be advised that Wisconsin Administrative Code SPS 326 requires you to submit the Manufactured home community plan before work begins on the community. This requirement applies to new or expanded Manufactured home communities.

SPS 326 defines a "Manufactured home community" or "community" as any plot or plots of ground upon which 3 or more Manufactured homes that are occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes are located. The Manufactured home community license is valid until June 30, every even numbered year, at which time it will require renewal.

Please submit the following to apply for a new Manufactured home community license or to be approved for a community expansion:

- MANUFACTURED HOME COMMUNITY PLAN--Submit at least 2 copies of a detailed drawing that clearly shows the location of each site, distance on all sides of units and between any other buildings and property lines, location and width of streets, location of street lights, and location of the well and septic systems and one set of specifications, if applicable.
- PLUMBING PLAN--If the community contains a private sewage system, you must submit documented proof from the Department of Safety and Professional Services, of a plumbing plan approval for the septic systems, waste collection/drainage systems, and water distribution system.
- 3. <u>WATER QUALITY TEST</u>--If the community contains a private water supply, you must submit documented proof of a safe water sample. Please contact our office if you need a list of testing labs.
- <u>APPLICATION FOR MANUFACTURED HOME COMMUNITY LICENSE</u>--Complete the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Manufactured Home Community License Application (enclosed) and submit with the appropriate fees.
- 5. <u>SCHEDULE AN INSPECTION</u>--After plans and approvals are received by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, an inspection will be scheduled to determine compliance with the Manufactured home community code.
